The Southern Welsh Association held it's meeting on July 13, 2002, at the home of Helen and Lee Wagner.

Minutes from the previous meeting were read and approved.

Old Business

October 2002 Shows:

A location was needed for the October shows. Options were discussed, including Marlboro Farms in Newberry, FL.

2003 Show Dates:

It was brought to the group's attention, that people traveling from out of state have requested that the club hold two consecutive one-day shows, rather than a single day of showing, as it makes their travel time more worthwhile.

In order to compromise and meet needs of all members, it was decided that we will hold two days of consecutive shows in July and October and will hold single day shows in February and April. This was moved by Helen Wagner, seconded by Mike Smith and all present were in favor.

July 2003 Show:

It was noted that a class list needs to be completed for the July 2003 show.

Judges' Clinic:

The Judges' Clinic is scheduled to take place on October 26, 2002. It was noted that we do not yet have a clinician secured, nor a location. Preferred amenities of the location were noted, including: an affordable covered arena, bleachers, and a good P.A. system. Brenda Heberling agreed to check on the availability of White's arena in Chiefland, FL.

Book Audits:

The first book audit is scheduled to take place on Saturday August 3.

New Business

Advertising:

The need to advertise our upcoming shows was discussed. Sherrie Southworth agreed to contact "Horse & Pony" newspaper to list our shows. She also agreed to contact some additional pony people who might be interested in receiving the prize list. Celia Evans suggested placing a box ad in Horse & Pony along with periodic listings. The group decided to place a 1/8 page advertisement, six weeks prior to the show, at a cost of \$67. This was moved by Leah McFarlin, seconded by Celia Evans and all present were in favor.

The possibility of listing the Southern Welsh Association in the Florida Barn Books was discussed. Leah McFarlin agreed to check on the cost for such a listing.

Newsletter:

It was noted that the sponsor cards cost \$200/yr and that they haven't been renewed, so the cards will be removed from the newsletter. Anyone who wants to buy a sponsorship to be featured in the show programs or newsletter, should be directed to Barbara Lender or Mike Smith. The cost of show sponsorships will be listed in the prize lists.

It was also noted that phone number and location of next meeting needs to be included along with the date of the next meeting. It was noted that newsletters will only be mailed to paid members, with a complimentary copy going to Cecil Dunn.

Class Costs:

A new method of paying for performance classes was discussed. Participants would be able to pay a \$35/day max per pony to participate in as many classes as they would like. Cost otherwise will be \$5 per class. This was motioned by Helen Wagner and Seconded by Sherri Southworth. After further discussion, an amendment was motioned by Mike Smith, that the procedure be tried on a trial basis for the October show. The motion was tabled until after the October show, to see how turnout is and what the financial impact would be for the association.

Ribbons:

We have enough full sets of ribbons for the October show. After the show, we will look at changing which ribbons we use. We will be using useable items (lead lines, etc.) for first place prizes for people who travel in to the shows and also for new people and children.

Supreme Champion Classes:

It was moved to eliminate the Supreme Champion class from our Bronze Shows. Motioned by Sherrie Southworth, seconded by Mike Smith and all present were in agreement.

Combining Classes:

Classes will be combined on the prize list for the October show (example: Juniors and Seniors; A's, B's and Cobs). Classes may be split at the show, upon the discretion of the Secretary if there are enough participants to warrant splitting.

November 15th Show:

A show Secretary is needed. The show is to take place on a Friday, which will make participation difficult for some club members.
