How many years have you been involved with the Welsh?

We have been involved with horses/ponies since the 60's. We owned ½ Welsh and Tenn. Walkers. From there, we went to Quarter Horses and Thoroughbreds. In 1986 we activity started breeding, raising and training Welsh Section A's. Our first stallion was GTF Master Mark and our mares were Periwinkle Ticked Pink, Periwinkle Pixie, Periwinkle Petit and Hickory Hill Petit Four.

What are the goals of your breeding program?

As of this year, we are standing two Section A's stallions and hope to add a Section C stallion to our line up. We are currently trying to build up our Section C breeding herd and maybe add 1 or 2 more Section A mares.

Who are the current Welsh in your equine family?

We have four Sections A's, three Sections C's and two Half Welsh. SECTIONS A's are B's Mark of Perfection, (Mark) stallion, black, (GTF Master Mark X Hickory Hill Petit Four)

Loafer's Lodge Pip, (Pip) stallion, Grey, (Twyford Cadog X Glendower Joyful Snowdrop)

Whispering Northern Lass, (Lass) mare, (GTF Abby's Midwest Miracle X Doncardeb Sweetie Pumpkin)

Whispering Shadow, (Tess) mare, (Westrum's Special Dandy X Doncardeb Sweetie Pumpkin)

SECTIONS C's are Bell Road Barn's Show Tune, (Tune) mare, (Dai Hanesydd Y Penrhyn X Winks Funfare)

Dragon's Lair C Sharp, (Ducky) mare, (GTF Master Mark X Madoc Rhiannon)

B's Kkydyd, (Kid), Gelding, (Blaengwen Dafydd Y Gwas X Whispering Northern Lass)

Are others our half welsh and they are: Silk Stockings (GTF Master Mark X Satin (QH) and B's Malyki (B's Mark of Perfection X Mocha (QH). Other non-welsh include Silver (Arabian), dam of B's Silver Pumba, Elroys Silver Streak (Warmblood) and a Paint mare for our warmbloods.

What are your plans/goals for the coming year?

Mostly our plans will not change too much. Brenda has many ponies to start training in harness this year, so she will be kept busy. She will be starting Pip and Kid in harness and finishing Ducky in harness and over fences. Our goal is to get a driving

pair together and find a buggy for them, that in its self is a task.

Any highlights you would like to share?

This year was a very good year for showing. Our Jr. herd sire (Pip) was Reserve Jr Champion at the Va. Welsh Breeder Show in July and won a Supreme Champion at the SWA Show in June. We sent out Tune to be bred to The Governor and she is now back home and happily in foal. We are extremely happy with the training progress of our other Sec. C mare Ducky, she has really matured this year and looking forward to next year to showing her in driving and over fences.

What efforts have you made to promote Welsh, outside of the Welsh community?

We are always striving to promote the welsh to others. This year we showed at the Fl. State Fair Carriage Driving Show with Mark and Lass. Brenda showed open 4H shows in driving, as well as presenting driving clinics using Welsh ponies. Barbara showed Ducky in the Alachua Open 4H show. At the last Alachua show Ducky won the Open Hi-Point Hunter award against all the Quarter Horses and Thoroughbreds. Teri, showing her pony Silk, won many awards including a silver buckle for a championship in open shows in central Florida.
