The judge's decision is final.

All Welsh ponies six years & over, showing in breeding classes and all Welsh and ½ Welsh showing in performance classes **MUST BE MEASURED** or present a valid WPCSA or USEF measurement card. Measuring will be done between 8 and 8:30 AM.

The judge, rules committee or show grounds manager may intercede in any situation that appears unsafe to exhibitors, animals or bystanders to reduce the possibility of accident or injury. Any acts of discourtesy or disobedience to the judge or officials, or the part of the owner, rider or groom shall disqualify the ponies and the owner shall forfeit his/her entry fee and other fees.

WPCSA Class Descriptions

Breed Classes

Animals are to be shown in hand at a walk and trot except in group classes. Purebred Welsh to be judged 85% on breed type, conformation, way of going, quality and substance and 15% on disposition and manners. Natural reaching action is desired. Half-Welsh to be judged 85% on conformation, way of going, quality and substance and 15% on Welsh breed type, disposition and manners.

VSE Halter

Open to all ponies 50 inches and under, all ages, breeds and sex. Judged 85% on conformation, way of going, quality and substance – 15% on type, disposition and manners

M&M Halter

Open to all Dartmoors, Connemara, Shetland, New Forest, Dale, Fell, Highland and Welsh Ponies, fillies, mares, geldings, colts and stallions, all ages.

Open Halter

Open to all ponies 14.2 hands and under, all ages all sexes.

Performance Classes

WPCSA Welsh English Pleasure (Article 112.3)

To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring on light contact without martingale. To be judged 75% on performance, manners, movement and style; 25% on breed type and conformation. Working class to be judged 100% on performance.

WPCSA Welsh Western (Article 112.4)

To be shown at a walk, jog and lope both ways of the ring on light

contact without martingale on a reasonably loose rein without undue restraint. To be judged 65% on performance with an emphasis on manners; 25% on breed type, movement and conformation; 10% on appointments. Working classes are judged 100% on performance.

WPCSA Welsh Hunter (Article 112.5)

Over fences(o/f): To be shown over a course of a minimum of six fences with eight jumping efforts of the required height. To be judged 75% on performance, manners, movement and style; 25% on breed type and conformation. Working classes judged 100% on performance. Animals not exceeding 13.2 hands will jump 2'0", animals exceeding 13.2 but not over 14.2 hands shall jump 2'6". Animals exceeding 14.2 hands jump 2'9". Under saddle (u/s): To be eligible, pony must have shown in and completed an over fences class. To be shown at the walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. **May be required to gallop one way of the ring, but no more than eight animals at one time.**

WPCSA Pleasure Driving (Article 113.1)

To be shown to a suitable two or four-wheeled vehicle or four-wheeled vehicle for pairs, but not a viceroy, racing sulky or fine harness rig. To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, working trot and trot on and stand quietly and except for tandems, **to back readily**. To be judged 75% on performance, manners, movement and style; 25% on breed type and conformation. Working classes are judged 100% on performance.

Wire wheeled vehicles are allowed, no cantering allowed in driving.

Removing the bridle from an animal harnessed to a vehicle, or leaving an animal unattended while hitched, anywhere on the show grounds, will result in instant elimination and removal from the show grounds.

Open Carriage Driving

WIRE WHEELED VEHICLES PERMITTED. In addition to the gaits detailed in the pleasure driving section, carriage driving also requires the slow trot which is slower and more collected. **PICK YOUR ROUTE** – driver must drive through ALL pairs of cones either direction, one time and one time only. **TIMED OBSTACLE**-driver must negotiate every pair of cones in the numbered and lettered sequence. Fastest time without faults wins. There will be a 5 second penalty for every ball knocked off of a cone. In the case of a tie. The less penalty points reign over the faster time with more penalties. **WORKING** is judged 100% on performance
